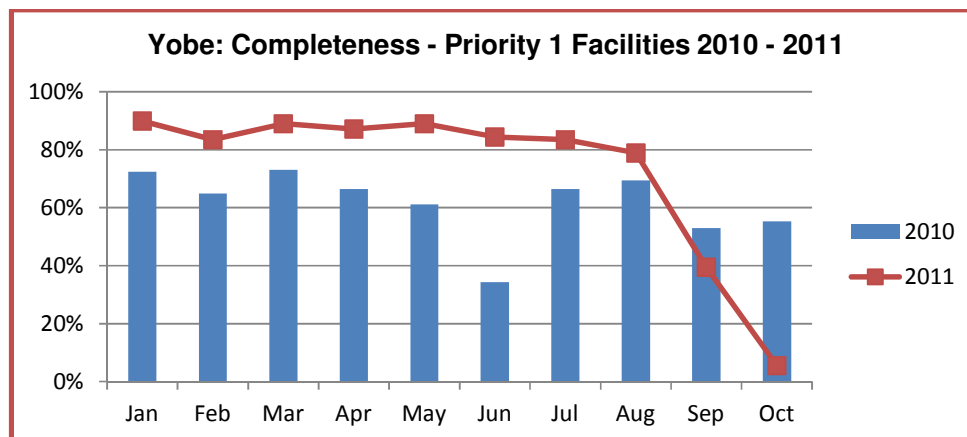
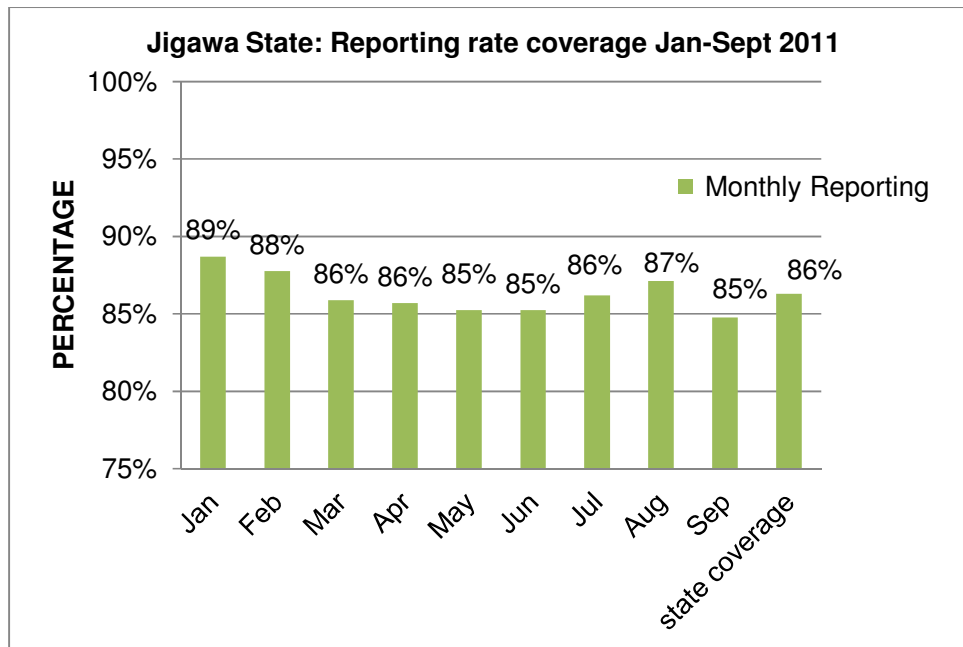


Supporting states to develop plans built on evidence from HMIS

Note that the September 2011 drop off is due to the fact that this was created in October and data will still be coming in.

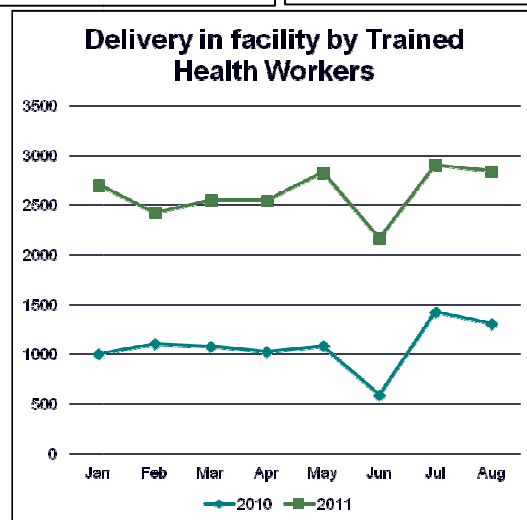
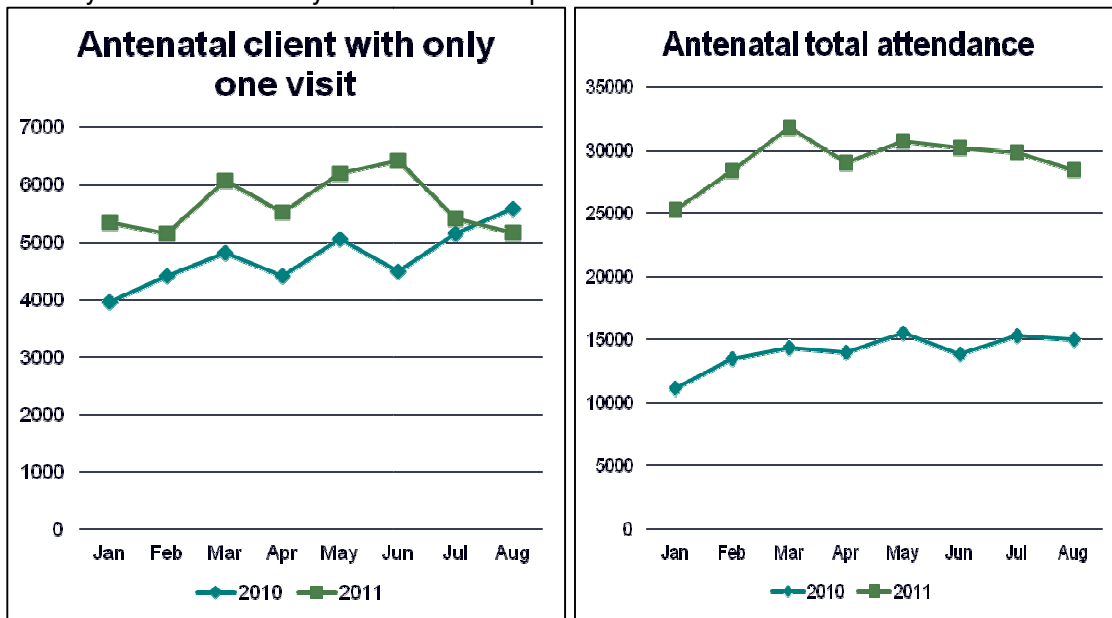

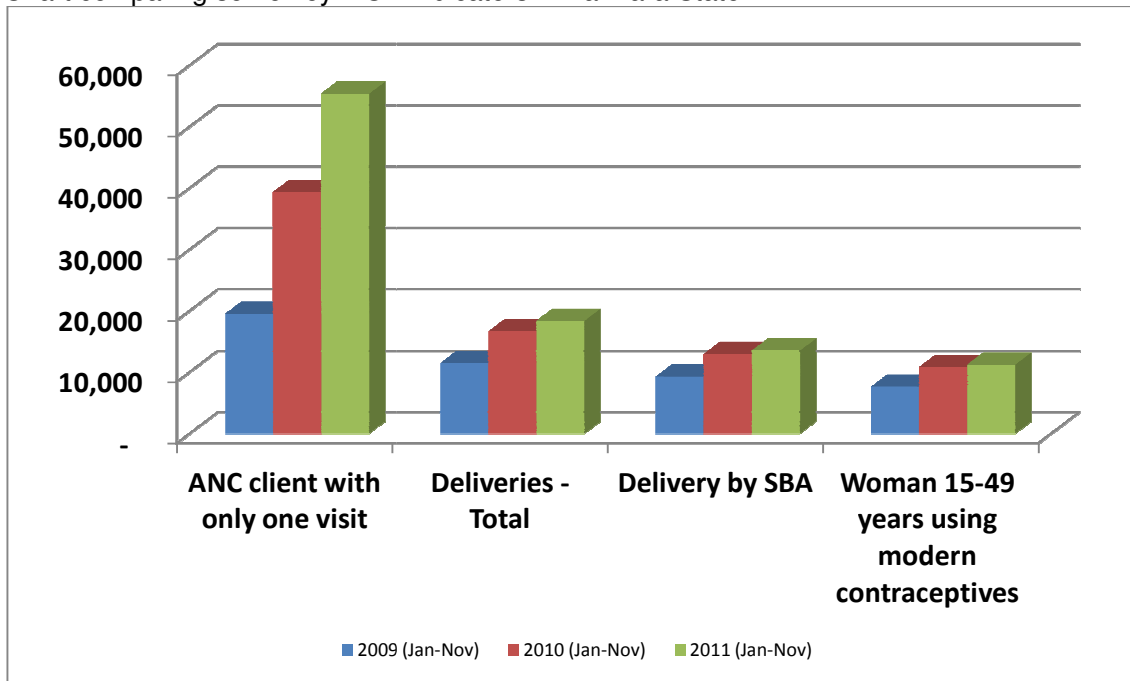
